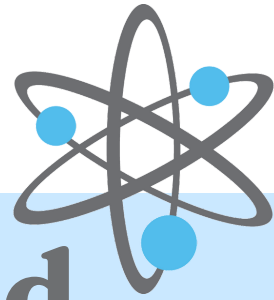

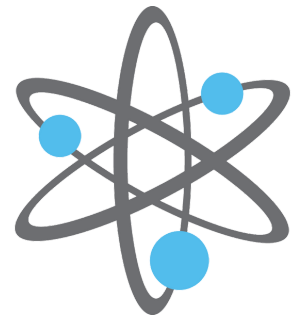

# GrantWriting Board

*A program that trains students to support fundraising efforts for organizations*

## HOW IT WORKS:

- 1** Philanthropy Lab students who want to continue their experience apply to join a cohort of students from top Universities all over the US.
- 2** Each selected student nominates an organization they met in their Philanthropy Lab course as their proposed GrantWriting Board Partner Organization.
- 3** If selected, Partner Organizations commit to working alongside their Grant Writing Board Rep as they seek out funding opportunities and draft applications.
- 4** Students are trained together by the Philanthropy Lab to identify and write grant applications.
- 5** GrantWriting Board Reps will utilize materials developed in their class about the organization, as well as anything the Partner Organization can provide to assist in drafting applications (previous grant applications, marketing materials, etc.)
- 6** GrantWriting Board Reps identify potential funding partners and ask their Partner Organization if they are interested in applying.
- 7** GrantWriting Board Rep then confirms any details needed to draft the application (purpose of grant, dollar amount, any materials needed), and puts together a draft for the Partner Organizations review.
- 8** With approval from the Partner Organization, GrantWriting Board Rep finalizes and submits the grant application.
- 9** The GrantWriting Board connects consistently to help one another apply for grants and share best practices, ideas of potential funding partners and leverage resources.
- 10** The Partner Organization receives additional funding to support their mission + GrantWriting Board Reps gain valuable experience & support their communities!
